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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Choose, organise and use a range of techniques, tools and materials according to the effect they have. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use drawing, painting, sculpture, collage, photography (...) to represent the world or create products of their imagination |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop a personal expression, departing from stereotypes. |

IMPLEMENTING AN ART PROJECT

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify the main tools and skills needed to produce an art project. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understand the steps in the creation of an individual or group project, anticipating possible difficulties. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify and accept one's role in a process of group creation. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adapt one's project to the constraints of realisation taking the spectator into consideration. |

EVALUATING AND ANALYSING CREATIVE WORKS

IDENTIFYING ARTISTIC DOMAINS, BE OPEN TO ART
