Stage 13 in Britannia

New language features: infinitive, use of 'volo', 'nolo', 'possum' and 'que' Practising the language: identify missing words, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 22 new words Translating: 4 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: Life in Roman Britain

#### Autumn - Mid-Term Holiday

Stage 14 apud Salvium

New language features: infinitive + difficile, necesse, etc, adjectives

Practising the language: identify adjectives, agreement of adjectives, identify missing words, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 23 new words Translating: 6 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: The Romans in Britain (timeline, map, conquest, romanisation and trade, Boudicca's rebellion)

Stage 15 rex Cogidubnus

New language features: relative clauses, imperfect of 'volo', 'nolo', 'possum'

Practising the language: identify and translate relative clauses, irregular imperfect tenses, identify missing words, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 22 new words Translating: 4 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: Cogidubnus, king of the Regnenses in Roman Britain

#### Winter Holiday

Stage 16 in aula

New language features: pluperfect tense, relative clauses with 'quas' and 'quos'

Practising the language: identify missing words

Vocabulary: 23 new words

Translating: 4 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: Fishbourne Palace and gardens in Roman Britain

#### Winter - Mid-Term Holiday

Stage 17 Alexandria

New language features: genitive case

Practising the language: identify missing words, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 22 new words Translating: 3 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: the ancient city of Alexandria under Roman rule

Stage 18 Eutychus et Clemens

New language features: gender (agreement of adjectives and relative pronouns)

Practising the language: identify words, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 22 new words Translating: 5 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: Egypt under Roman rule

## **Spring Holiday**

Stage 19 Isis

New language features: vocative, 'hic' and 'ille', imperative 'noli' and 'nolite'

Practising the language: identify and translate hic and ille, imperative and vocative case, identify missing words and endings, translate sentences

Vocabulary: 24 new words Translating: 6 Latin stories

Demonstrating knowledge of Roman civilisation: The worship of Isis in Ancient Rome

New language features: present participle, 'is' and 'ae' in accusative, genitive and dative

Practising the language: identify and translate present participle + pronouns, identify missing words, translate sentences and text

Vocabulary: 20 words + 14 numbers

Translating: 6 Latin stories
