

# Scheme of Work - Progression

Art

Year 7 / 6ème

NB: Art lessons take place during one semester only for each class

Period 1	<p><b>The Formal Elements Part 1</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Title Page Design:</b> students will develop understanding of lettering technique by the use of guide lines and visual design skills</li> <li>- <b>Mark Making:</b> students will complete a chart that demonstrates a variety of mark making techniques. They will then be given an image with which they have to match the artist's marks</li> <li>- <b>Tone:</b> students will make a "Tone Ladder" that shows different tonal values from dark to light and will then be given an image with which they will match the different tonal values</li> <li>- <b>Form:</b> students will apply tone to 3 drawn shapes to visually convey a 3-dimensional solid by using a light source</li> <li>- <b>Colour Part 1 / The Colour Wheel:</b> students will learn basic colour theory by making a colour wheel. They will be taught primary and secondary colours and application of acrylic paint</li> <li>- <b>Colour Part 2 / Harmonious Colours:</b> students will learn of specific colour groups. They will then be given a line drawing to which they will apply harmonious colours using oil-pastel</li> <li>- <b>Positive and Negative Space:</b> students will make a collage of an African mask to demonstrate two types of space</li> </ul>
Period 2	<p><b>The Formal Elements Part 2</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Symmetry / Japanese Notan Art:</b> Students will make an example of Japanese Notan art that demonstrates 3 axes</li> <li>- <b>One-point Perspective Part 1:</b> Students will understand how to make a one point perspective drawing of Flying Boxes</li> <li>- <b>One-point Perspective Part 2:</b> Students will learn how to make a one point perspective drawing of a furnished room</li> <li>- <b>Texture:</b> Students will make a collection of various textures from around the school by frottage</li> <li>- <b>Proportion:</b> Students will learn how to draw accurately by using the grid technique</li> <li>- <b>Assessment:</b> Students will be assessed on prior learning</li> <li>- <b>Christmas Card:</b> Students will learn how to make a 3-dimensional pop-up greeting card</li> </ul>
Period 3	<p><b>The Formal Elements Part 3</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Illustration / Quentin Blake:</b> Students will learn information and answer questions on Quentin Blake and create a section of a book tower in the illustrator's style</li> <li>- <b>Portraiture:</b> Students will learn how to make a proportionally correct portrait drawing by using measurement and an understanding of shape</li> </ul>
