

Scheme of Work - Progression

Art

Year 8 / 5ème

NB: Art lessons take place during one semester only for each class

Period 1	<p>Take 3 Artists</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Vincent van Gogh: Students will learn about and answer questions on the artist. They will then make a postcard size transcription of "The Starry Night"- Jean-Michel Basquiat: Students will learn about and answer questions on the artist. They will then make a postcard size transcription of "Undiscovered Genius of the Mississippi Delta"- Henri Matisse: Students will learn about and answer questions on the artist. They will then make a postcard size transcription of "Icarus" <p>Pointillism</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students will learn about the art movement, Pointillism and make 4 studies using the Pointillist technique- Students will make a Pointillist landscape artwork in the style of Seurat <p>Proportion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Students will learn how to draw proportionately by using basic shapes
Period 2	<p>Frida Kahlo / Portrait</p> <p>Students will learn biographical information and answer questions on the artist. They will then make a portrait drawing.</p> <p>Illustration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Quentin Blake: Students will research their 5 favourite books. They will then draw and a paint a section of the book tower in the style of Quentin Blake- Quentin Blake Typography: Students will create an animal alphabet to write their own name with <p>Collage / Antonio Gaudi</p> <p>Students will learn information about and answer questions on the architect. They will then work in teams of 3 to create a section of a Gaudi inspired collage. The collage will be displayed around the classroom to form a frieze</p>
Period 3	<p>Sculpture</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Claes Oldenburg: Students will work in teams to design and make items of food and drink using newspaper, tape, papier mache and paint <p>Christmas Cards: Students will learn 3D design skills</p> <p>Assessment</p>
