About Us

Ecole Jeannine Manuel London opened in 2015 as the youngest of three Ecole Jeannine Manuel schools. Originally founded in Paris in 1954 as the expression of an **unwavering belief in education as the key to a better world**, our school shares its mission and teaching methods with its French sister schools.

With students representing **more than 80 nationalities across our campuses in London, Paris and Lille**, Ecole Jeannine Manuel is a truly international community where students learn to **Think, Dare, Share & Care** together. Students follow our ambitious programmes in a nurturing environment, enabling them to develop their **agency** throughout their educational journey.

Our school's academic excellence matches its diversity. Admission to Ecole Jeannine Manuel is highly competitive: successful applicants have strong academic potential, demonstrated ability or interest in co-curricular areas, and excellence of character.

Curriculum & Baccalaureates

Up to the end of Middle School, we follow the French national curriculum with notable exceptions as half of all lessons are taught in English. The curriculum is enriched at all levels, not only with a more advanced English language and literature program, but also, for example, with Chinese language teaching.

In 11th grade, students choose between the **International French Baccalaureate (BFI)** or the **International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB)**:

- In our **IB Diploma Program**, all subjects are taught in English with the exception of language-based subjects, such as French, which are taught in the language by native speakers. All students enrolled in the IB program prepare the full IB diploma and a majority of our students prepare the demanding **bilingual version of the IB** which replaces Language B with a second Language A module.
- Our school offers the **American section of the BFI**, a demanding bilingual and bicultural programme developed by the French Ministry of Education in partnership with College Board. Over the two-year programme, students who have chosen the BFI track follow a **core curriculum** (consisting of French Literature, Philosophy, Civics, Scientific Literacy, a Modern Language, PE and a Research Project), **three concentrations*** (one of which is dropped at the end of 11th grade) and **three BFI-specific college level courses. Total instruction in English accounts for up to 40% of the diploma.** As part of their BFI, our students take **two American APs**: European History and English Literature and Composition.

* possible concentrations include : *History, Geography, Geopolitics and Political Science; Humanities, Literature and Philosophy; Mathematics; Physics and Chemistry; Economics and Social Sciences*

French Baccalaureate: 100% success rate, all with honors, including 73% Summa Cum Laude ("mention Très Bien") and 27% Magna Cum Laude ("mention Bien")

International Baccalaureate: 100% success rate with a 36 average (vs. a world average of 30)

Extracurricular Activities

Although the high number of teaching hours mean that our students have less time to dedicate to extracurricular activities than their American counterparts, they nonetheless participate in as many projects as they can. In the IB track, all students complete the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) program which enables them to make positive contributions to wider society while developing skills such as collaboration, problem solving and decision-making.

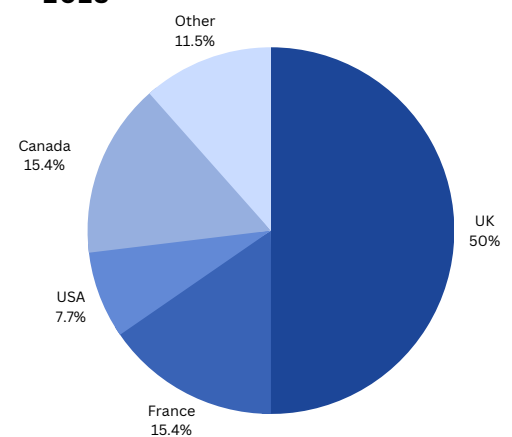
