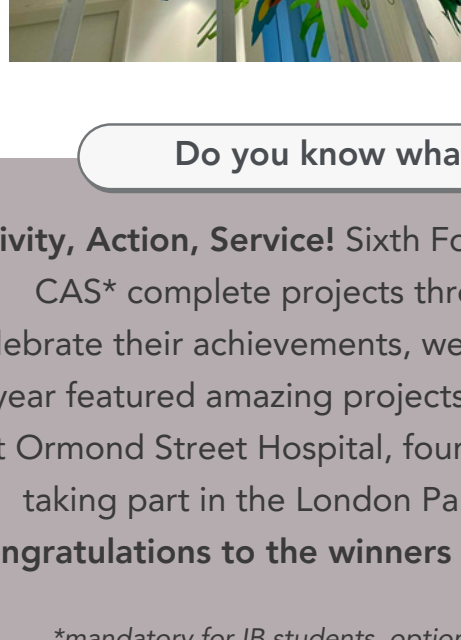
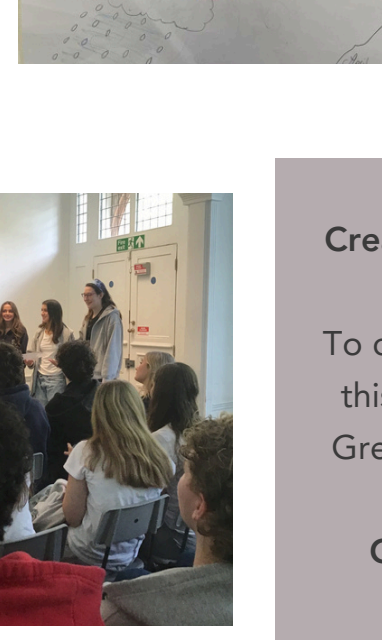


## Top Kangourou Results!

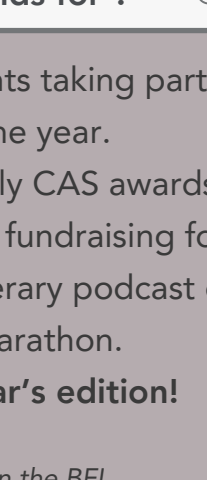

Earth Day Display in Primary School

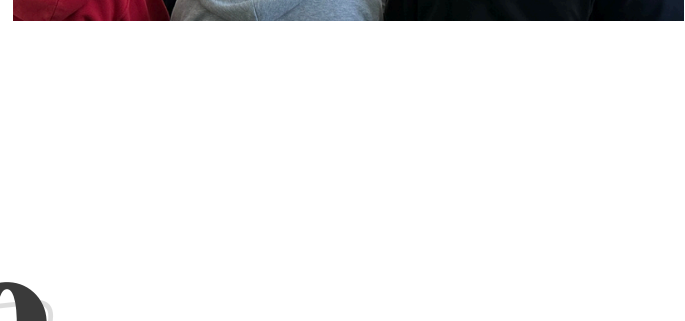


**Do you know what CAS stands for ?**

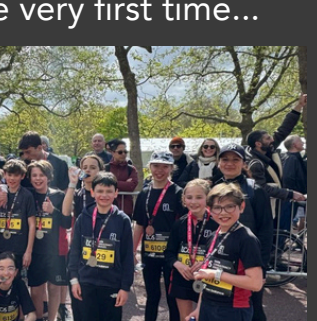


## Life at School
