Period 1	<p>1. Drawing: Students will develop their drawing skills from secondary observation in a variety of media</p> <p>2. Painting: Students will learn the technique of watercolour painting, understanding its properties and produce both a landscape and still life composition.</p>
Autumn – Mid-Term Holiday	
Period 2	<p>3. Printmaking: Students will understand how to make a linocut reduction print and produce an edition of 4 colour linocut prints.</p>
Winter Holiday	
Period 3	<p>4. Theatre Design: Students will work in teams and make preparatory studies for a stage design inspired by a fairy tale. The design will depict one scene from their chosen story. Students will learn how to make a model stage set from a variety of materials which includes a backdrop, flats and props.</p>
Winter – Mid-Term Holiday	
Period 4	<p>5. Icons and Idols: Students will learn how to make a proportionate drawing of their chosen Icon / Idol. They will use A2 buff coloured sugar paper as a surface and black and white compressed charcoal to describe form (making their work look 3 dimensional)</p>
Period 5	<p>6. Museum Visit: Students will be taken to a local museum / art gallery and make primary observational drawings.</p> <p>7. Sculpture: Students will study various properties of sculptural materials and make a free standing sculpture inspired by architecture</p>
