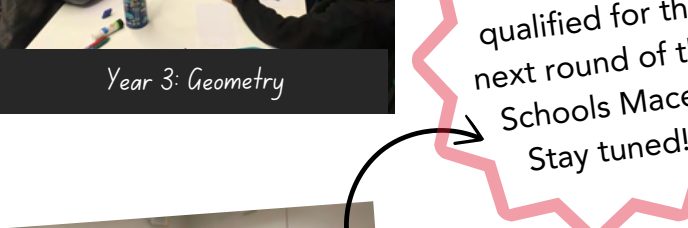

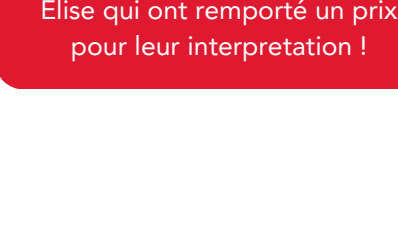

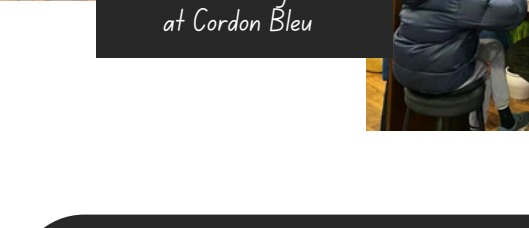

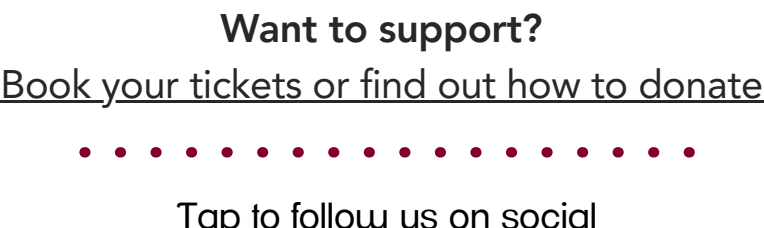
**What unique opportunities do our students have because of the dual curriculum and international focus of Jeannine Manuel?**
